

## Brass Rubbing at Blakesley Hall

Brass rubbing is a simple activity which requires patience and care. Brasses were memorials to wealthy people and usually laid in the floor or walls of churches.

### How to make a good brass rubbing:

- Fix your paper over the brass, using masking tape to hold it still.
- Gently feel over the paper to find the outline of the brass.
- With a brass rubbing stick, lightly shade in the area of your brass.
- Then, carefully darken the brass rubbing. The darker you can make it the better it looks.

**Only one or at the most two brass rubbings per child.**
