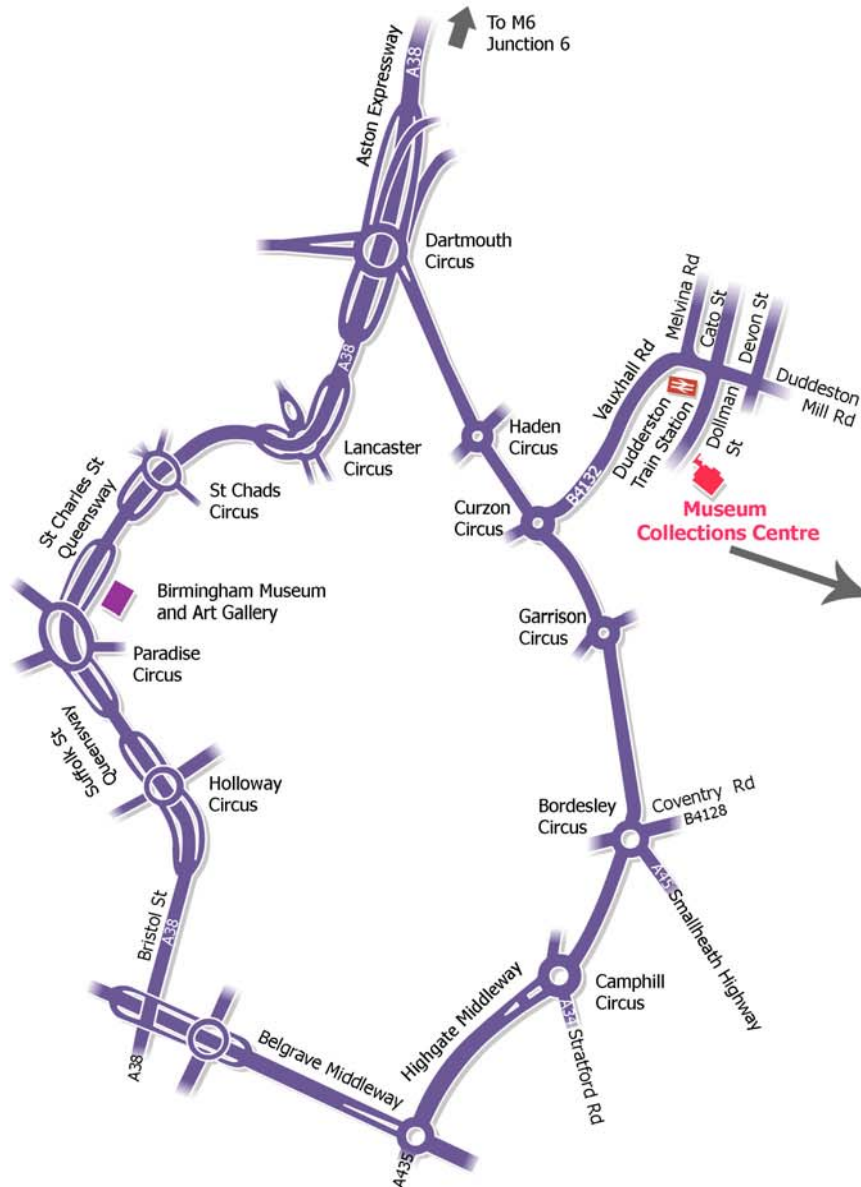

INTRODUCTION AND HOW TO BOOK

This brochure lists the loans available from Birmingham Museum & Art Gallery.

HOW TO BOOK

1. **Photocopy** the blank **booking form** at the back of this leaflet as you may wish to make a later booking.

Complete both the **Loan Agreement form** and **booking form** and send to:

A confirmation of your booking will be sent to you.
It is advisable to book as far in advance as possible.

Please do not make a booking unless you are absolutely sure that you will use the box.
The loans service does not accept cancellation of bookings.

Please note that some loans are periodically removed for redevelopment or conservation. Whilst every effort is made to give you your first choice of loans, we may, occasionally have to offer alternatives.

LOAN PERIOD

The loan period is for a half term, approximately 3 / 4 weeks.

WHERE TO COME

COLLECTING AND RETURNING

Loans day: Wednesday on designated weeks only.

Time: 3.00 - 6.00pm

Please make sure that loans are collected and returned on the dates **arranged**.
Do not take them out unless you are sure you can return them on the date due.

Boxes which are not collected as arranged will be delivered within three working days to the school which made the booking, incurring the late notice delivery fee of £35 (this may increase if a school is inaccessible).

OPTIONAL DELIVERY SERVICE

Alternatively if you prefer not to collect from the Museum Collections Centre we operate an optional delivery service for Birmingham LEA schools and those in the surrounding areas, whereby you can have your loans delivered to your school.

This service operates at a small charge to cover costs;

Birmingham LEA Schools

£20 per half term or £70 for a year (6 half-terms)

Non Birmingham LEA Schools in Sandwell, Solihull, Sutton Coldfield, Walsall, Smethwick, Oldbury, West Bromwich

£20 per half term or £80 for a year (6 half-terms)

Non Birmingham LEA Schools – Wolverhampton, Coventry, Cannock, Warwick, Redditch

£25 per half term or £90 for a year (6 half-terms)

CARE OF LOANS

The teacher who orders the loans is responsible for looking after them.

Most of them are irreplaceable and should be treated with respect! Please keep them in a secure place in school, especially overnight. If any loss or damage occurs, please inform the Schools Loans Service at once. **Do not attempt repairs.** Children can try on the replica costume, but please choose children of suitable size! Any damage to replica costume and artefacts will be charged to the school concerned, so that we can purchase replacements.

LATE RETURNING OF LOANS BOXES WILL INCUR A FINE

There is a fine of £5.00 per day for late returns of loans boxes. Those opting for the delivery service must have loans boxes ready at the School's Reception desk from the Monday of each loans collection week.

HISTORICAL LOANS

Please check all items are present when you re-pack loans.

They will be checked in your presence when you return them or when they are collected.

NATURAL HISTORY LOANS

Specimens in the natural history collection that are not suitable for handling are displayed in Perspex boxes which give an 'all-round view' when removed from their carrying cases. **Some boxes are quite large, heavy and difficult to carry.**

Please make sure that the Perspex boxes are correctly positioned on the runners within the wooden boxes. If they are transported incorrectly it can damage them.

SUGGESTED CROSS CURRICULAR LINKS

Whilst the loans boxes have been listed by subject, they contain resources that can be used to support teaching across the curriculum. We have made some suggestions for subjects which may be supported by the specific loans boxes.

All loans can support Personal Learning and Thinking skills and the Every Child Matters agendas.

RECOMMENDED KEY STAGE

We have recommended the different key stages we feel that the loans boxes are most appropriate for. However, we welcome other suggestions for where they might creatively fit into the curriculum.

RinR LOANS

With support from Renaissance in the Regions funding stream, the service has expanded its range of loans boxes. These newer loans boxes are highlighted as "RinR" on the loans list.

TAUGHT SESSIONS

The Loans Development Officer can deliver sessions in your school or at the Museum Collections Centre designed to introduce the box to pupils and establish best practice.

FREE INSET

We provide INSET sessions at the Museum Collections Centre where the Loans Service is based.

Forthcoming INSET sessions will be held on :

Wednesday 9th June 2010 4.15pm- 6pm

Sessions include a welcome tour of the Museum Collections Centre.

The Sessions provide :

- An introduction to the resources available
- Information about how to access them
- Hints and Tips about using artefacts in the classroom.

We also offer whole school INSET either at your school or at the Museum Collections Centre, by arrangement with the Loans Development Officer.
