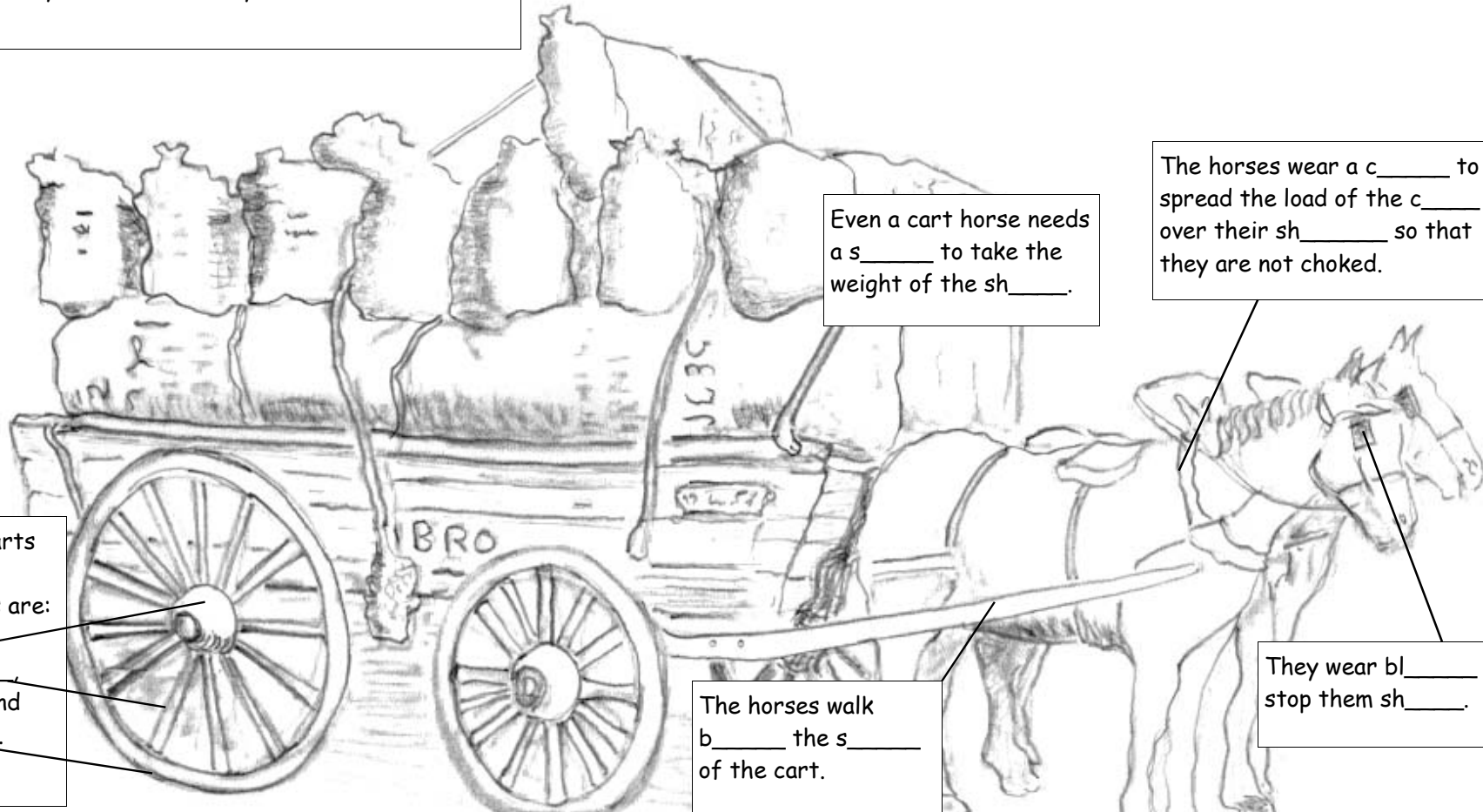


Victorian Britain - Transport

The horses wear a collar to spread the load of the cart over their shoulders so that they are not choked. They wear blinkers to stop them shying -(being distracted by things that might make them bolt) Even a cart horse needs a saddle to take the weight of the shafts.
